



Duston Williams Joins Stion's Board of Directors as Audit Committee Chair

He most recently held the position of Chief Financial Officer of Infinera Corporation (INFN), a leading manufacturer of high-capacity optical transmission equipment. Previously, he was CFO of Maxtor Corporation from 2004 until its 2006 acquisition by Seagate Technology (STX).

Stion recently announced a \$70M Series D financing and has begun expanding its San Jose, CA manufacturing facility to 100 MW. Stion's panels are specifically designed for use in all major applications, including commercial / government, residential, utility and off-grid.
